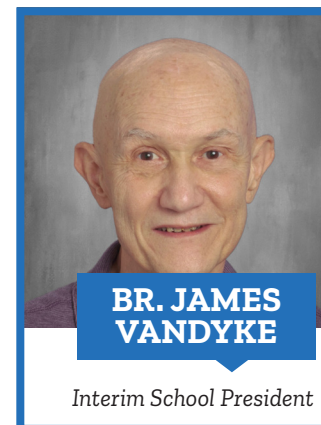

# CONGRATULATIONS CLASS OF 2024

At Holy Trinity, great education starts with what you learn—and becomes more powerful when it shapes who you are. Every day, Holy Trinity students, faculty, and staff support and inspire one another to pursue new challenges, growth, and deeper meaning. From the first day a student passes through the Division Street doors, they are being prepared for life after high school. Every year, during the first week of school, freshmen take a trip to the University of Notre Dame and Holy Cross College. And it just keeps going! ## AN EDUCATION OF THE HEART



Josh Boahene was Holy Trinity's class of 2024 Valedictorian, graduating with a 4.32 GPA. He was a track star, placing 2nd in state and breaking school records. He was accepted to numerous universities such as University of Notre Dame, University of Southern California, and University of Kentucky. He landed on Northwestern University where he was offered a 4-year, full-ride scholarship. This fall he will major in biological sciences with a concentration in cell and developmental biology.

Josh learned about Holy Trinity in seventh grade when his mother told him about a friend's daughter who was a student. He applied and was accepted. He admits that when he first attended Holy Trinity, his spiritual life had withered. He felt disconnected from his faith. Attending services felt like an obligation, not a choice. But when he attended Kairos, a weekend retreat designed to help students reconnect with themselves and explore their spirituality, everything changed. With his peers, spurred on by student-led discussions and workshops, Josh thought deeply about his spiritual life and how his faith practice could support his desire to be his very best every day. Rekindling his spirituality strengthened his relationship with God, himself, and his entire community. He is grateful for his time at Holy Trinity and attributes his drive and self-discipline to his Holy Cross education. Josh looks positively to his future and we are excited to watch him soar!



# MADE POSSIBLE BY YOU

November welcomed the much-anticipated Farley Learning Commons. At the grand opening, students, faculty, and staff welcomed the entire Holy Trinity community- donors, board members, alumni, and friends to tour the elaborate new spaces. Hundreds of people lined the halls of Holy Trinity radiating enthusiasm for what this renovation will bring our students. The energy was felt on every floor, as people shared their excitement for the impressive new spaces. The event closed with a celebratory dinner in the newly renovated cafeteria. Board members stood before the audience and regaled them with stories of how far The School has come- and the possibilities that lie ahead because of the dedication and commitment of our generous community.

So how did it all begin? Holy Trinity announced the MAKE Possible Campaign in March 2022, designed to raise funds for a new Learning Commons, building repair and restoration, and scholarship support in the amount of \$7.5 million. By November 2023, through the generosity of our selfless donors, The School raised \$8.4 million, exceeding all expectations and paving the way for Holy Trinity to be competitive with Chicago's most elite high schools. The Make Possible Campaign was successful due to wonderful donors and multiple matching gifts provided to help encourage donations.

Through the brilliant and generous work of Wight and Company architects and Kelly Construction and Design general contractors, the Farley Learning Commons is designed to foster innovation and collaboration, support our transformative college and career services program, expand the possibilities for teaching and learning in the arts and B-STEM (Business, Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math), and inspire students to actively engage in the development of their faith. The Farley Learning Commons makes up much of the second floor of The School and includes a Counseling Center, Entrepreneurial/Business Collaboration Hub, Teaching Center, Chapel, and an Innovation Lab.

Along The School's north wall, sunlight floods the spacious Ron and Leslie Ezerski '64 Innovation Lab. With a Sound Lab, a Dry Lab, and a Messy Maker Space, possibilities are endless here. Lab tables, task spaces, and electrical outlets span the vibrant room, with Promethean boards on both ends. This is where the Farley Learning Commons Directors offer courses in Holy Trinity's world-class B-STEM Program. From technical skills in software development and financial literacy to hands-on practice in entrepreneurship and business development, the 4-year B-STEM Honors Program provides students with the skills needed for advanced degrees, and the experience required to apply them in the real world.

Sliding glass doors provide easy passage to The Robert J. Buford Entrepreneurship Hub from the Ron and Leslie Ezerski '64 Innovation Lab. Ideas come to life in this room. Shiny white dry erase boards separate mobile seating groups so that classes can be easily divided into teams and reconnected for collaboration. Strategy, Planning, Operations,





# The Farley Learning Commons

Economics, Networking, Market Research and more come alive in this space. This classroom accommodates The School's award-winning NFTE (Network for Teaching Entrepreneurship) Program which produces nationally recognized winners year-after-year.

Next door, The Raitt Family Counseling Center houses our full-time counseling team who addresses and ensures the advancement of every students' academic, personal/social, and career development. The staff takes time to get to know each student and implement targeted strategies to prepare them for postsecondary opportunities. Counselors hold classes on how to write impactful college resumes and fill out applications. College scholarships are researched through The Raitt Family Counseling Center as well as the college visit program- which allows students who have been accepted to colleges 200+ miles from Chicago to take an all expense paid exploration trip. From the first day a student passes through the Division Street doors, we are preparing them for their postsecondary lives, and it all starts here.

Across the hall, in The Craig and Kelly Dean Chapel, walls are adorned with stained glass created by world-class designer Chris Botti, whose work can also be found in such places as

Saint Patrick's Cathedral in New York and the Chicago Cultural Center. It is a dedicated space for students, faculty, and staff to reflect on their spirituality and humanity and learn about our Holy Cross heritage. It serves as the center for Holy Trinity's Campus Ministry Department. Through the Craig and Kelly Dean Chapel, opportunities are organized for students to connect, serve, and step into leadership. Campus Ministry coordinates service and outreach projects both within The School as well as the wider Chicagoland area, plans the monthly all-school Mass, and organizes prayer services and other events to enrich students' spiritual lives. In The Craig and Kelly Dean Chapel, students learn that success is measured by the growth of their hearts as well as their minds.

Blessed Basil Moreau said, "To what end would it serve students to know how to read, write, calculate, and draw, or to possess some notions of history, geography, geometry, physics, and chemistry if they are ignorant to their duties to God, to themselves, and to society..." Holy Trinity upholds that belief as we support nearly 30 student-led special interest clubs annually. The Henry and Leslie Berghoef Teaching Corner, with its mobile furniture and modern design, is in the heart of it all, serving as the hub for The

School's club program. Holy Trinity's vast offering of clubs rivals that of any other school. It serves as a launchpad, giving students the chance to get involved in the life of The School while providing opportunities for leadership and for practicing organizational teamwork skills.

Numerous events have already been hosted in the Farley Learning Commons. In fact, other schools and organizations, such as Big Shoulders Fund and Maternity BVM, used the spaces for student and family events. Recently, Steve Tortorello, Director of Partnerships and Special Projects for the Office of Catholic Schools in the Archdiocese of Chicago, toured the Farley Learning Commons and said, "No other Catholic High School in Chicago has this!" Holy Trinity is forever grateful for the life changing Farley Learning Commons designed to encourage students to reach out of their comfort zone and embrace new challenges, to develop the competence to see and the courage to act in our world. The Farley Learning Commons reimagines the typical learning space. It blurs the boundaries between subjects and opportunities, pushing students to explore, collaborate and create in stimulating ways, and keeps Holy Trinity competitive with top-tier high schools. 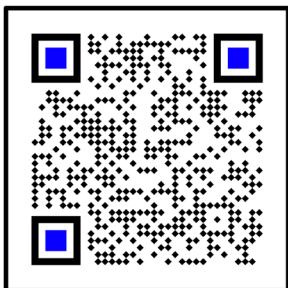
# HOLY TRINITY IS ROOTED IN HOPE

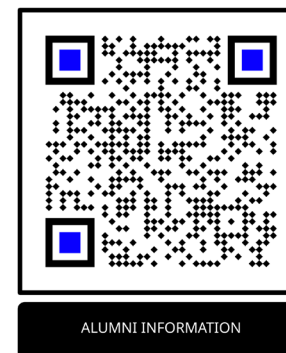


# ALMA MATER MATTERS

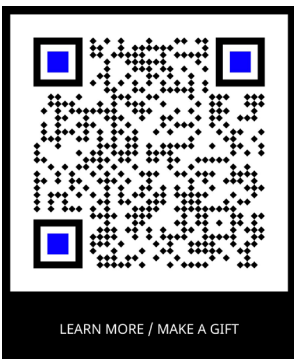


# THE 1910 SOCIETY

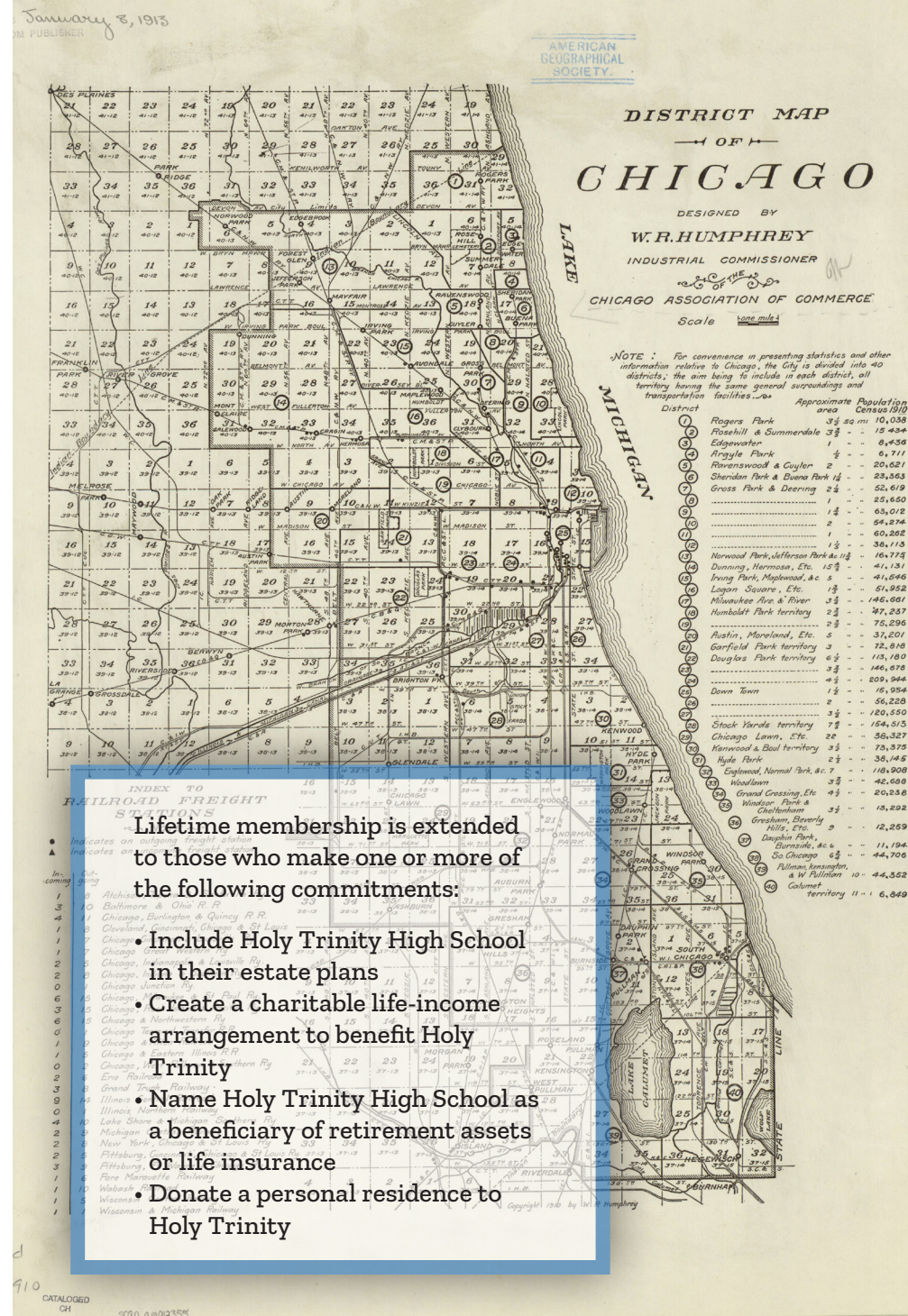

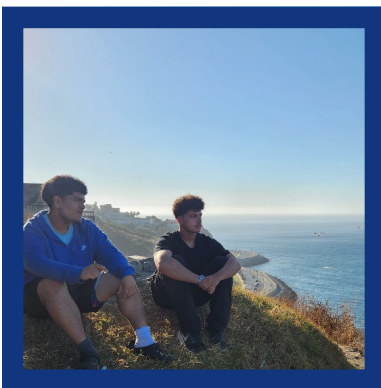

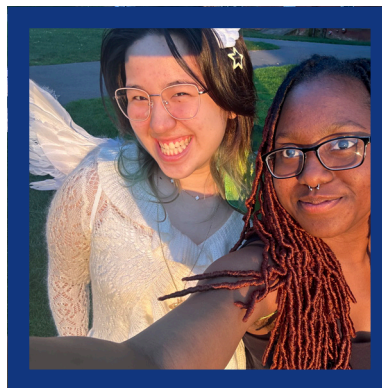
# WHERE IN THE WORLD

Education must go beyond instruction to focus on who you become in the process. Keeping with the spirit of the Holy Cross tradition, our values anchor all we do as we challenge and nurture students academically, spiritually, and personally to lead lives of service. Over the summer, a number of our students packed their bags and left Chicago to broaden their horizons and focus on their growth. Here are three of their stories:



Senior **Gerardo Hernandez** studied Arabic this summer in Morocco on a National Security Language Initiative for Youth (NSLI-Y) scholarship. He lived with a host family and was immersed in the local culture.

Smith College, an all women's school located in MA, hosted a program called "Women in STEM". Senior **Paisley Brown** took coding classes with programs like Python and Makecode which she considered "challenging, but fun". She said, "It wasn't work all the time. We also enjoyed time outside to really take in the opportunity, and to try new things. The food was also really amazing! The program gave me what the college experience would be like, and what it means to be a student at Smith College."



**Camila Valencia**, a senior, also attended summer programs at Smith College. She was there for a month and studied Women's Public Health



Issues. In addition, Camila went to Washington DC with the Congressional Hispanic Caucus Institute (CHCI) Next Generation Leadership Program 2024. She was selected out of 1,000 applicants from all over the country. Camila was one of seven students selected from Chicago and the only one from a Chicago Catholic School. Camila says, "This was an inspirational program where I spent a week learning about policies and what goes into them. I also learned about how Latinos are underrepresented in Congress, and the work we need to do to get equal representation. I met incredible people, including Chuy Garcia's assistant and Congresswoman Delia C. Ramirez. I will forever remember this experience."

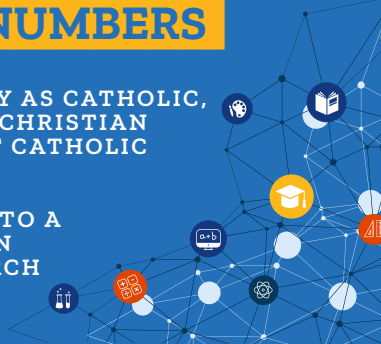
## FRESHMAN CLASS OF 2028, BY THE NUMBERS

## OPERATING EXPENSES





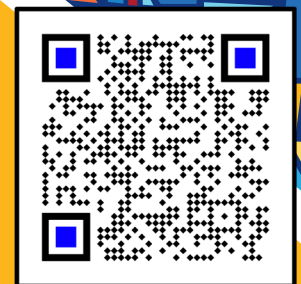
